READING THE BIBLE I TO I

1. Read the passage aloud together
2. Read back over the passage on your own looking for:



A light bulb - anything that shines out in the passage and draws attention. It can be something important or something that particularly strikes you.



A question mark - anything that is hard to understand; something that you would like to ask the author about.



An arrow - anything that applies personally in your life.

3. Write down at least one thing - and no more than three things - in each category.
4. Share your *lightbulbs* and discuss.
5. Share your *question marks* and have a go at working out answers together from the passage; (it doesn't matter if you can't find an answer).
6. Share your *arrows* and discuss.
7. Pray together about what you have learned.

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
